Dems To Compete In 2 Primaries

Democratic voters will have a choice in two of the three suburban congressional districts in the Aug. 6 primary. There's a two-man contest in the 19th District—Democratic primary and a three-man fight in the 2nd District.

News of the incumbent congressmen—Republican Marvin Esch of the 15th and Republican Jack McDonald of the 19th—has primary opposition. Filing deadline was Tuesday afternoon.

FIGHTING FOR the chance to take on McDonald will be Ron Mardiros, a Livonia businessman and Democratic Par-

ty leader, and Gary Frink, former congressional aide and an attorney who lives in Waterford Township near Pontiac. McDonald, former Redford Township supervisor, is seeking a second term after unseating incumbent Democrat Billie S. Farnum in 1966. Farnum is now working with the Democratic National Committee but maintains his Michigan residence.

It's a young man's race, McDonald is 36, Frink 35 and Mardiros 37.

The 19th District includes the local communities of Redford Township, the City of Livonia, and Farmington city and township.
