## Festival Registration At Fourth Of July Parade Closes July 1

Tomorrow, Monday, July 1, is the last day to make application to run a concession during the Farmington Founders Festival July 25-27.

Application may be made at the Farmington Board of Commerce office in the Masonic Temple, Grand River and Farmington Rd.

For the first time, concession managers will be charged a fee of \$10. The charge is made to help defray costs of promoting the festival and to help expand its scope. Ten percent of concession net profits must be returned to festival funds. The 10 percent may be deducted as an expense in determining net profits. Cleanup and housekeeping expenses will be billed to the concession. Location of various concessions will be made by the Board of Commerce depending on date of receipt of application.

## Senator Hart To Speak

A day-long Fourth of July celebration complete with parade, oratory, games, dancing and fireworks will mark Thursday's observance of Independence Day in the adjoining Kendallwood and Colony Park subdivisions of Farmington Township.

Special guest of the occasion will be Michigan's senior United States Senator, Philip A. Hart, who is scheduled to deliver the day's principle address at 11:30 a.m.

Hart, who was elected to the Senate in 1958 after two terms as Michigan's lieutenant governor, will speak at the Wooddale School.

Residents of the two subdivisions between 12 and 13 Mile Rds., west of Farmington Rd., have been asked to decorate their homes in keeping with Independence Day tradition.

A parade through the area at 10 a.m. will conclude at Wooddale School to set the stage for Senator Hart's appearance. The afternoon and evening programs will be punctuated with games, contests and dancing. The climax will be reached with a fireworks display adjacent to the school at dark.

General chairman of the day's fest: titles is Jack A. McMann.
