### MSC Dorm Rates Boosted In January

Michigan State College students will find their dormitory rates slightly higher when they come back to the school for the winter term.

Dormitory food fare was boosted a term for all students, and men students will get an additional \$3 increase in room prices a quarter. Winter term food rates will be \$188 for men, compared to \$175 last year, and \$193 for women, compared to \$185 last year. Increased rates were necessary because of rising food and labor costs, college officials said.

### Special Deer Season Brings Only Light Kill

Opening days of the special western Michigan deer season produced a light kill, according to the conservation department.

Fewer hunters were in evidence in the first four days of the season this year, with blocked backroads and generally poor hunting conditions hampering their efforts.

Some of the 21,800 permit holders are unable to hunt since they already bagged their deer in the general season in November.

### Tom Goers Receives Promotion In Korea

Thomas E. Goers, USN, son of Mr. and Mrs. Fred Goers of 22141 Springbrook, was recently advanced to aviation machine's mate, third class, while serving aboard the escort aircraft carrier USS Sicily, now a part of the U. S. Pacific Fleet in the Korean war zone.

The Sicily carries the famous Marine Corps Black Sheep fighter squadron and until recently was commanded by Capt. J. S. Thach, USN, originator of the "Thach Weave," a fighter plane tactic developed and widely used during the last war.

Captain Thach was recently promoted to Rear Admiral.

William H. Butler of Massachusetts, the personal friend of Coolidge, was defeated that year by a young Democrat named David I. Walsh. Butler had been appointed to the senate, following the death of Henry Cabot Lodge, And 20 years later, in 1924, the young Democrat, Cabot Lodge, grandson of the old senator, defeated Walsh, the man who defeated Butler. So goes the cycle of politics.

Coolidge, like Truman, a former vice-president, had entered the White House in 1923 through death, and — again like Truman — was easily re-elected in 1924.

But the 1928 off-year election put a coalition of Democrats and progressive Republicans in control of the senate, just as a coalition of Republicans and southern Democrats will now control under Truman. And in 1928 Coolidge decided that he did not "choose to run."

Wonder if President Truman, whose career has been strangely similar to Coolidge's, will choose likewise? Mrs. Truman very much wants him to.

Note — After Coolidge bowed out, the Republicans, under Herbert Hoover, were overwhelmingly elected in 1928 in the Al Smith campaign, only to lose office in 1932 and for 20 long years thereafter.

#### MERRY-GO-ROUND

Though the secret service has increased the President's bodyguard since the assassination attempt, Mr. Truman is as carefree as ever. "When the Good Lord calls me, he'll take me," he tells his guards.

A boom is already developing for Sen. Clinton Anderson of New Mexico for vice-president in 1952.

Senator Taft's campaign was so well financed that he had \$15,000 to spare for the senate race of Lieut. Gov. Joe Hanley in New York.

The man who is charged with keeping the Democrats in control of the senate for the next two years is really Dr. George Calver, the Capitol physician. If one Democrat senator dies in a GOP state it would tie the senate; if two die the Republicans would control.

Dr. Calver's chief health advice to aged Democratic senators is: "Keep out of filibusters. It's too hard on the heart."

#### CAPITAL CHAFF

The Anderson Stenographic Reporting Service, suspected of handing a secret senate transcript from the Kefauver crime committee to a Chicago Sun-Times reporter by mistake, is in for investigation. This is the same company which also transcribes top secret atomic energy hearings.

### TRAINING TEACHERS IS ONLY ONE PART OF U-M UNIT'S WORK

Preparation of teachers is only one of the many services performed by the University of Michigan School of Education.

Dean James B. Edmonson has prepared a list of extra activities of the school and its faculty in serving the schools in Michigan during the past year.

The list includes the publication of articles of interest to school teachers, special conferences on the campus, cooperative programs on special teaching problems, participation in regional workshops and membership on important state committees, councils and special services in vocational education, directed teaching, off-campus instruction, an extensive Summer Session program for teachers, and work with agencies of the federal government so that members of the faculty can keep current with developments of importance to the schools of Michigan.

Still other services as listed by the dean included the participation of faculty members in the activities of the University's Bureau of School Services. This has included visits to schools and taking part in workshops, county institutes and similar programs.

The faculty also gave commencement addresses in many Michigan schools and took part extensively in the programs of the Michigan Education Association and the Michigan Association for Childhood Education.

And still another service as cited by the dean was the considerable amount of time devoted by various members of the School of Education faculty to conferences with individual teachers, principals, and school administrators on a variety of problems.

### Cpl. James Mousseau Gets Combat Infantry Badge

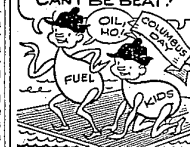

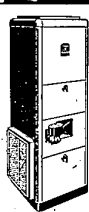

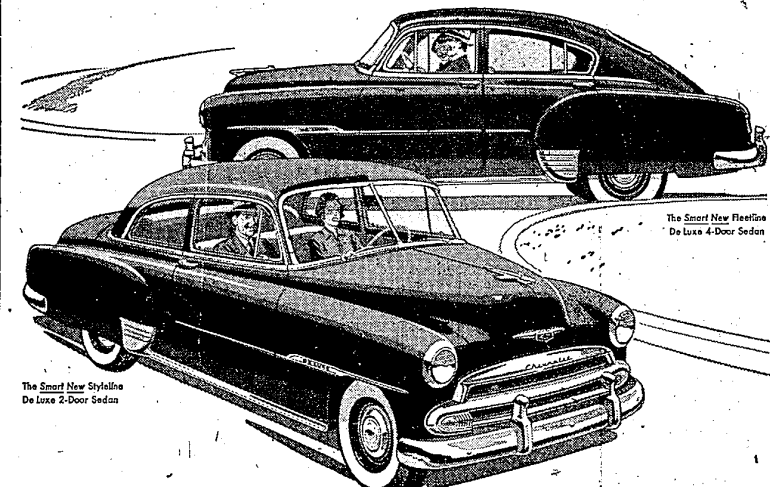
