Ever wonder why the extra day-ight during February and March hows up more in the evening than in the mornings?

in the mornings?
It's because our standard clock times are farther ahead of the sundial or real sun times during these months than at any other time of the year, according to Dr. Hazel M. Losb, assistant professor of astronomy at the University of Michigan.

astronomy at the University of Mi-chigan.

"For example, in the Michigan area during February, the sun does not reach the noon meridian, a point midway in the sky, until ap-proximately 12:49 mm. Eastern Standard Time." she reports. "A-round the first of November, the sun reached the meridian at 12:19 pm. This tends to make the after-noons longer, especially toward the end of the month when there is about an hour more of daylight." STATE OF MICHIGAN


