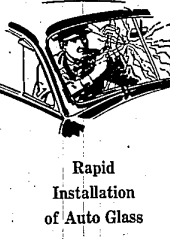

youngsters at the institution or get the darned thing out of here."

The "Little Hoover Commission" still is kicking up dust in Michigan. Latest recommendations ask creation of a stronger and more centralized treasury department. This department would absorb the present revenue department, state board of excise, gasoline tax division of the secretary of state's office, municipal finance commission and part of the auditor general's office.

But state officials aren't too alarmed. Says one worker: "It sounds good in theory — but could they set up the new department and would it work?"

Another bugaboo of the legislature has breathed its last for another year or two. The possibility of a four year term for Michigan governors has been swamped by a bi-partisan vote in the house of representatives. Long sought by governors — and others — the question will arise again, he assured.

Recently diverted to schools, cities, villages and townships? That's why the legislature is having such a tough time trying to find a new source of revenue as inflation mounts the cost of public services and as remaining state funds are more and more restricted.

State Bounty Payments Triple In January

The conservation department reports state bounty payments more than tripled in January and cost the state \$22,190. Payments were made in 5,240 foxes, 52 coyotes, 17 bobcats and one wolf as compared to \$8,400 paid in December for 1,175 foxes, 123 coyotes, 22 bobcats and one wolf.
