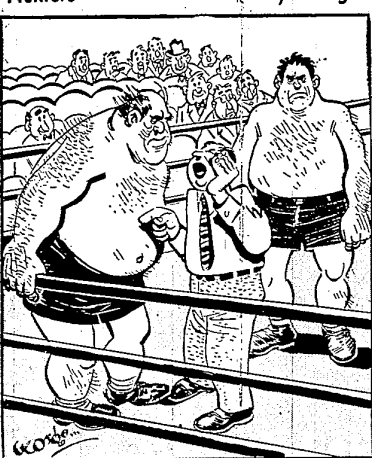

Peking's red dictator, Mao Tse-tung, has imported Soviet experts to run the "anti-hand" extermination campaign. Some reports claim that up to half a million Chinese have been killed or arrested in this campaign in the last year.

SOPPING THE GRAVY

While small firms have been left out in the cold, the giant corporations have been sopping up all the gravy in defense subsidies.

Already the big companies, such as U. S. Steel, have been granted over two billion dollars in tax subsidies for defense expansion. Yet at the same time, applications from small firms and newcomers are gathering dust in government offices.

These government subsidies are in the form of accelerated amortization — or rapid tax write-offs — on new plants which the government approves for the defense effort. The certifying agency is the national production administration, which has been giving big business all the breaks.

For example, U. S. Steel, through its subsidiary, Carnegie-Illinois, has obtained over \$300,000,000 in tax write-offs for one plant at Morrisville, Pa.

The truth is that small business

is getting a worse deal than labor from mobilization boss Charles Wilson.

U-M WILL BE SITE FOR TOWN MEETING OF THE AIR APRIL 24

"Why Worry About the Atom Bomb?" will be the topic for discussion when "America's Town Meeting of the Air" is broadcast from the University of Michigan campus on Tuesday, April 24, starting at 8 p.m.

The broadcast from the Rackham Lecture Hall will originate over Radio Station WJMY in Ann Arbor and will be carried by 235 affiliated outlets of the American Broadcasting Company network.

The April 24 program is under the auspices of the University's Phoenix Project and the Ann Arbor Junior Chamber of Commerce. G. V. Denny, Jr., president of Town Hall and founder and moderator of "Town Meeting," will be here to preside in his usual role. The panel of speakers will be announced in the near future.

"America's Town Meeting" is a modern adaptation of the old New England town meeting where citizens gathered to discuss the problems of their government. It has been on the air since May, 1935.
