The opening of the road was in the public interest.

Spess stated that he would agree to opening the 33 feet if the Township would pay for the material he has put in the road over the past 12 years. At the present time Spess has blocked the road. He stated he put up the barricade when the road began to break down under increased traffic. Spess stated that he estimates he has spent \$500 on the road. He stated that the opening would benefit only a few residents. He added that he did not want to deed any additional property of his to the Township.

The Township Board moved that no money be paid to Spess for the 33 feet of public roadway and that it be opened for public use. The board also decided to turn the matter of condemnation proceedings for the additional 33 feet of property over to the county attorney for consideration.
