same as for the past two years. The Board also approved a resolution that the first and third grades be placed on half days next fall. During the past year the first grade has been on half days. 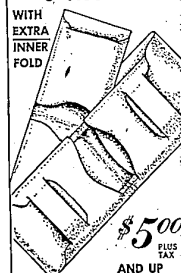
