Broiler Provides Quick Meat Dishes

Main dishes to pop right out of your broller and onto the dinner table are the pride of homemakers on a warm summer day. With this in mind, Reba Staggs, home econ-onist, makes several "broiler" sug-

omist, makes several "broller" sig-gestions.
Meats that are quickly brolled and, likewise, present thrifty serv-ings include ground beef or lamb patties, Canadin-style bacon, ba-con, liver sausage and corned beef hash from the canned meat shelf. In broiling these meats, the same as steaks and chops, make sure that you use a moderate cooking tem-perature. If meat is cut I inch thick, place it on the broiler rack so that it is 2 inches from the heat. If cut thicker, place it farther from the heat.

If out thicker, place it farther from the heat.

When you turn the meat on the second side, add the vegetables to the broiler. Seasonal vegetables to color the serving platter can be tomato halves or pre-cooked potaces, carrots or cauliflower. Potato cakes are another choice. Cooked whole kernel corne speaking grand with agnosed meats. Fruits must not be forgotten. Peach or pear halves or pineapple rings add colorful additions.
