

ENROLLMENT AT CLARENCVILLE UP ABOUT 9.5%

Enrollment in the schools of the Clarencville School District climbed to 1,530 as of Monday morning according to Louis Schmidt, superintendent of schools.

Schmidt pointed out that this figure will continue to increase for several weeks until all the youngsters have returned to classes. Enrollment in the elementary schools, kindergarten through the sixth grade, was given as 990. The total is expected to go well over the 1,000 mark in the next few weeks.

Enrollment in the junior and senior high schools was 540 as of Monday. Schmidt stated that enrollment in the grades is up approximately 11% over last year's enrollment with the junior and senior high school enrollment up about 5%.

Lift Oakland County Dog Ban

The Oakland County dog quarantine imposed April 17 has been lifted. E. F. Ballou, deputy animal warden reported.

The ending of the quarantine was the result of a joint decision by the State of Michigan's Departments of Agriculture and Health.

To dog owners it means their animals may now be released and do not have to be constantly on a leash or kennelled. But Deputy Warden Ballou warns that any dogs which cause a disturbance will be picked up.

Warden Ballou said, "I feel we'll have a series of incidents with persons being bitten unless people keep their dogs tied during the day because of school children."

At one time during the quarantine, Deputy Ballou reported, an average of one rabid dog was taken each day.

Few rabid canines have been discovered during the last 20 days and this is probably what the two departments decision is based upon.

Armed Bandit Holds Up Floral Park Confectionery

A lone man held up the Floral Park Confectionery, 20912 Grand River, late Sunday evening and escaped with \$59 in cash, city police announced Monday.

The bandit entered the store owned by Robert Cato and asked Mrs. Cato for some gum, when she turned to get it, the man drew a gun and stepped behind the counter to the cash register. Mrs. Cato called to her husband, who was in the back of the store, but the bandit halted him. After taking the money the man walked calmly out of the store and then ran down the sidewalk.

Police Chief Joseph DeVriendt gave the following description of the man: height 5 feet, 7 inches; weight 135 pounds; slim build; sunburned, sandy hair, neatly dressed in a pin stripe suit. He was bare headed. DeVriendt stated that police are now working on the case.

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FARMINGTON HITS NEW HIGH IN TOTAL ENROLLMENT

Enrollment in the Farmington Township School District is running slightly ahead of original estimates, Superintendent O. E. Dunkel announced Tuesday.

Total enrollment in both the grades and junior and senior high school is reported at 2,429 at the end of the first week. The Ten Mile School shows the largest enrollment in the elementary grades with a total of 668 children. Middle School is next with 910 and Bond reported 488 children. Enrollment in the elementary schools totals 1,556 at the present time. Dunkel stated that this total will be increased to an estimated 1,600 in about four weeks.

Junior and senior high school enrollment is listed at 873 as of the end of classes on Friday. High school enrollment is expected to reach 950.

That Summer Cold May Be Hay Fever, U-M Doctors Say

About nine out of ten persons suffering from hay fever believe they have a "common cold" or sinus trouble, according to doctors in the Allergy Clinic at the University of Michigan Hospital.

Unfortunately, many of these people mistakenly turn to nose drops for relief without realizing it may contain substances to which they are allergic, the U-M doctors explained.

Individuals who are in doubt regarding their symptoms of "runny" nose, sneezing, and "watery eyes", are indications of hay fever or a common cold should consult a doctor to obtain an accurate diagnosis, the Allergy Clinic pointed out.

The doctors explained that hay fever causes an increase of certain white cells in the blood stream which can be readily determined. The confusion between hay fever and the "common cold" probably arises because of the similarity of certain symptoms. However, the University physicians said patients with hay fever do not have a fever, even though they may feel hot.

Hay fever symptoms can occur year-round as the result of dust or the use of face-powder, toothpaste, milk or other foods that may contain substances to which a particular individual is allergic, the clinic declared.

The clinic doctors indicated that the widely-heralded drug, Cortisone, has proved very effective in treating some patients with allergic eye diseases involving conjunctivitis (inflammation of the eyelids).

Dr. John M. Sheldon, professor of internal medicine, in charge of the University Hospital Allergy Clinic, reported that new compounds, related to Cortisone, are also being used in certain allergy patients with a good deal of effectiveness.

However, he pointed out, these new compounds are still in the evaluative stage and not available for general use.

A new development in petroleum transportation is the use of aluminum pipe lines. The lightweight lines are said to be easier and less expensive to lay than steel. Lighter construction equipment can be used, the pipe does not require preliminary cleaning, does not have to be wrapped, and is much easier to weld than steel pipe.
