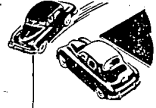

SOLVE PROBLEM OF FINDING RAM FOR SHEEP RAISERS

Help for sheep raisers in finding a top quality ram for their flock is on its way from the Michigan Sheep Breeders' Association, the Animal Husbandry Extension Department of Michigan State College and county extension offices, cooperating.

Graydon Blank, extension animal husbandry specialist at MISC, announced that purebred rams will be available for farmers of southern Michigan at the Ram Day, scheduled to be held at Michigan State College October 17.

Northern Michigan sheep raisers can get a ram at any of six stops on the schedule for the Ram Track. Local county agricultural agents can be contacted for further information and dates of the truck stops for the northern Michigan area. Selected rams of the Hampshire, Oxford, Shropshire, Corriedale and Suffolk breeds will be represented and will be priced according to quality. Farmers wanting to obtain rams of other breeds should so inform their county agricultural agent, Blank said.

State Park Crowd Close To 12 Million For Season

Labor Day crowds in state parks pushed 1951 attendance figures close to the 12-million mark. While unseasonably cold weather of early summer kept this year's attendance below the record of 13,108,000 of 1949, last year's total of 11,669,000 was exceeded two weeks ago.

Recent MSC Agriculture Bulletin Describes Dairy Success Factors

Factors which make for success in dairy farming are featured in a new Michigan Agricultural Experiment Station bulletin, "Dairying for Profit in Southeastern Michigan," now available to Michigan farmers.

GIVE SUGGESTIONS ABOUT DESTROYING BANGS DISEASE

Dairymen, hog raisers and goat producers have one thing in common according to Michigan State College extension veterinarians. That is a dislike of brucellosis, or Bang's disease. It strikes at the heart of dairy production causing a loss in milk production of 20 percent or more for each animal infected.

Test and slaughter are the surest and quickest ways to get rid of the disease. But even though that is the least expensive method in the long run, many farmers having a badly infected herd probably can not afford to dispose of it all at once.

When the test and slaughter plan can't be adopted immediately the MSC veterinarians suggest three plans as temporary measures to help a farmer clean up his herd more gradually.

One is to test and keep reactors until they can be disposed of without too heavy a loss, plus calf vaccination. The second is calf vaccination only. The other is adult vaccination.

CAREFULLY PACK FRUIT TO KEEP CUSTOMERS

When you pack your apples, pears or other produce for selling, remember to pack them as though you were going to use them yourself. You can get by the law by putting in a few off-grade fruits, but when your customers find these off-grade fruits they are not likely to come back for a second package, says Willard E. Bosserman, assistant county agricultural agent.

A uniform package is more attractive and therefore sells much better than one with fruits all different sizes. A package in which either all or most of the fruits can be seen sells better because your customers can see what they are getting.

Four quality, uniform and disorderly displays drives customers away, while orderly displays of quality produce attracts customers.
