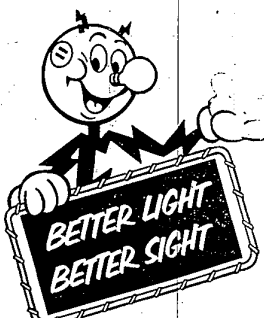

DEEP LITTER CUTS CLEANING TIME IN POULTRY HOUSE

If poultry raisers want to use the deep litter system they can simply add fresh litter to the present litter in the laying house.

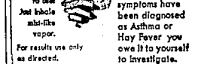
This idea should meet with approval because it saves the job of cleaning out the laying house, suggests J. M. Moore, extension poultry specialist at Michigan State College.

Aside from the labor-saving angle, the deep litter system will help overcome the problem of damp litter. If the poultry house is well insulated. And this well-insulated part is important, Moore says. He suggests four inches of wood shavings along the sidewalls and ceiling. Or a straw loft can replace the wood shavings for ceiling insulation.

Ventilation above the ceiling insulation is important in the poultry house so the malarial air can escape instead of condensing and running back down into the house.

The deep litter is built up by simply adding more litter and letting the hens mix it up with the old litter. It should be built up to about ten inches by the time cold weather comes.

Deep litter gives off heat, making the house warmer.

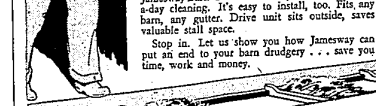
