"Germ" Warfare Not New**Civil Defense Authorities Define Biological Warfare As Old Stuff**

(Editor's Note: This is the first of a series of six short articles on biological warfare prepared by the Michigan Office of Civil Defense. The purpose is to acquaint the public with the dangers of biological warfare and to describe the counter measures that can be taken. This material is based on the Civil Defense booklet "What You Should Know About Biological Warfare.")

What is biological warfare? Biological warfare is the technique, well-known to our enemies, of attacking this nation with living agents such as plant-killing insects, with poisons or toxic bacteria, with special kinds of chemicals such as weed killers. Biological warfare is often called "germ warfare", but actually it is broader than that because it includes attack with chemical agents.

Biological warfare, Civil Defense officials emphasize, is a special weapon for use against special targets. It does not kill or sicken every person in a whole state or even in one city.

It attacks insects, toxins or chemicals can be aimed at people, animals or food crops, or all three at once. Such attacks can be launched by the armed forces of an enemy nation or by secret agents. Biological warfare is not a secret super weapon, CD experts state.

Wayne University Gets Navy Grant For Studies






