**MICHIGAN STATE POLICE ARREST 7,495 IN OCTOBER**

During October the Michigan State Police made 7,495 arrests, including 6,712 for traffic offenses and 783 for other offenses, according to the monthly activity summary compiled by the department.

Total arrests were up 28 per cent over the 5,857 for October last year and arrests for traffic offenses increased 31 per cent over the 5,129 of last October.

Not included in the totals were 128 juveniles taken into custody in connection with traffic and 404 during the same period last year.

Total travel in all activities was 992,131 miles. Officers also made 5,458,204 property inspections and 3,483 liquor inspections.
