Kids' Escape Is Play Theme

The story of how two children escape being the Blue Plate special for a witch who likes kids "with mustard on 'em," will be presented at Stevenson High School, 3350 Six Mile, Livonia, at 11 a.m. and 1 and 3 p.m., Saturday, May 27.

The play will be staged by the Production Players and is being sponsored by Echo, a Wayne County youth group. It's titled "Guess who we're having for dinner?"

TICKETS will be on sale at the door, at 75 cents for children and \$1 for adults. The play, written by Russ Vogel, is about a boy and a girl, Jason and Amy, who run away from a nasty uncle. They meet another boy, Harry, and stumble across an old cottage inhabited by a talking mirror and an old lady, a hippie witch. The witch

is entered in a cooking contest and doesn't want to lose to her friend, Witch Hazel. But Amy finds a magic wand, and the situation is saved finally with the help of a fire extinguisher filled with whipped cream.

THE PRODUCTION Players, formed this spring to promote children's theater, are hoping to release a feature-length film early in 1973. The players are headed by Vogel, a Livonian, and Marilyn Moore.
