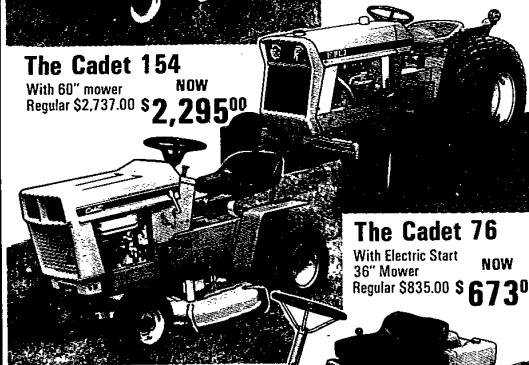

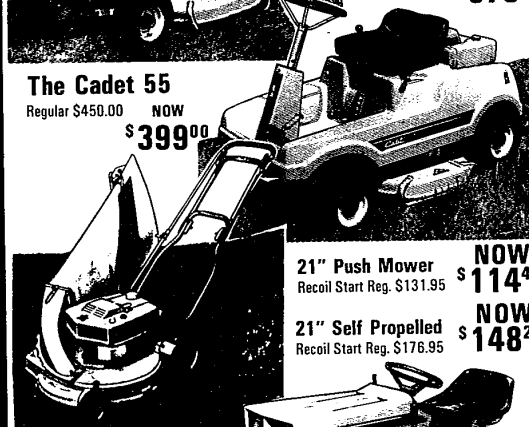

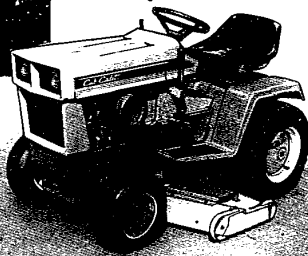

The Green Thumb

Home grown tomatoes: If you've never grown summer squash, then you've got a real treat in store. Modern summer squash hybrids take little space and produce bumper crops. You can sow four to five seeds per foot of row, or six to eight per cluster. If you sow seed in a group, be sure to thin them one foot apart in rows, or three plants per hill.

GROW SUMMER SQUASH: If you've never grown summer squash, then you've got a real treat in store. Modern summer squash hybrids take little space and produce bumper crops. GREEN THUMB CLINIC: "Our poinsettia is quite tall and we would like to start new plants. Can it be cut back?" Answer: Yes, cut the tops, back about half or more. Make four inch cuttings from the tops and root them in small pots or boxes of moist vermiculite, sand, or perlite. A clay pot filled with one of these materials makes a fine propagating "bench" for starting most house plants, including geraniums, violets, poinsettias, etc.

Plan A Rest Area To View Your Labors

In landscaping a yard, complement flower beds and other plantings with a restful area from which the finished scene may be enjoyed. Benches built into a corner privacy screen of 1x3-inch western cedar on 4x4-inch posts offer a quiet retreat and a place to chat with visitors. A combination garden house can provide storage for mower, other equipment as well as a covered area for a brunch table and chairs.

More Space, More Tomatoes

"The next time you consider staking tomatoes, think about the possibility of having fruit that is smaller and scalded," says Gerald E. Draheim, Wayne County extension horticultural agent. Many urban gardeners stake tomatoes because they want to get more plants per square foot. Although the practice does save space, Draheim points out that some problems may arise. Scaled tomatoes lose their bottom foliage and sometimes the foliage around the fruit. This could result in scalded or "sunburned" fruit. "Research has proved that unstaked tomato plants will supply as much as 10 pounds more fruit per plant than staked plants," says Draheim.

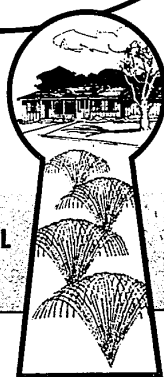
