

More Space, **More Tomatoes**

"The next time you consider staking tomatoes, think about the possibility of having fruit that is smaller and scalded," says Gerald E. Drahelm, Wayne County extension borticultural agent.

Many urban gardeners stake tomatoes because they want to get more plants per square foot. Although the practice does save space, Drahelm points out that some problems may arise.

Staked tomatoes lose their bottom foliage and sometimes the foliage around the fruit. This could result in scalded or "sinburned" fruit.
