

Orchard Lake Repair Set

The Oakland County Road Commission has announced plans to improve the intersection of Orchard Lake and Walnut Lake Rds. in West Bloomfield.

The construction contract has been awarded to Groleau Brothers Inc. of Union Lake for \$63,000. Construction will begin in June and is scheduled for an August completion.

The improvements will consist of widening the intersection to provide through, left and right turn lanes in all directions and will include installation of a traffic signal.

OCC Peace Group Has Class

A free Southeast Asian seminar is being offered to the public at 2 p.m. and 8 p.m. each Wednesday in Room J-222 on the Orchard Ridge Campus of Oakland Community College in Farmington.

The seminar, manned by volunteers from the OCC faculty and outside experts, is intended to inform people of the background and effects of U.S. policy in Southeast Asia, and to provide a non-threatening forum for rational discussion.

"We admittedly have a bias," says Ted Rancont, assistant professor of communications and coordinator for the seminars. "We prefer peace to war. But we are working consciously against our bias to present a balanced, objective view of the Southeast Asian situation. We are seeking informed speakers who can present the case in favor of current U.S. policies."

"The purpose of the seminars is education and information, not propaganda," Rancont said. "I invite anyone with some knowledge of the situation who wishes to speak for or against current U.S. policies to contact me. I will be more than glad to plug him or her into the Wednesday Seminars."
