Orientation

Madonna College is sponsoring two orientation sessions during its summer "On Campus Day" Thursday, July 27 at 2 and 7:30 p.m. The orientation sessions will offer information about Madonna's experimental program for men and women wishing to begin college or for those wishing to complete interrupted college programs. The program will also provide information for recent high school graduates and prospective transfer students as well. In addition, currently employed registered X-ray technologists and registered nurses from non-baccalaureate programs will have an opportunity to learn about completing degree requirements in radiologic technology and nursing respectively.

THE EXPERIMENTAL program offers adults regardless of past educational experiences the opportunity to pursue college courses on a trial basis before actually matriculating at the college. Credit earned in the trial courses is applicable to degree requirements. The only requirement for entrance into the experimental program is a high school diploma or qualifying GED results.

Applicants accepted into the experimental program as well as those admitted to other programs may pursue as few as one course or as many as five or six courses during morning, afternoon or evening sessions this fall.

The orientation sessions on July 27 will provide additional information about the College itself. Campus tours will also be available.

Road Maps
Available

The Southeast Michigan Council of Governments has published two specialized maps that are available on request for small fees.

One map shows all major roads and the other shows the boundaries of all minor civil divisions. Each covers the counties of Livingston, Macomb, Monroe, Oakland, St. Clair, Washtenaw and Wayne.

The regional road base maps will include projected freeway additions to 1975. Charges for the maps are \$1 for the 25 by 30 inch size (one inch equals four miles) and \$2 for the 48 by 30 inch size (one inch equals two miles).

Maps of minor civil divisions are free for the \$1/2 by 11 inch size (one inch equals 12 miles) and 50 cents for the 25 by 30 inch size (for one inch equals four miles).

SEMOG also published an updated bibliography, "Regional Publications and Planning Materials," which describes the council's research reports, plans, maps, slide index and aerial photography available to citizens of the southeast region.

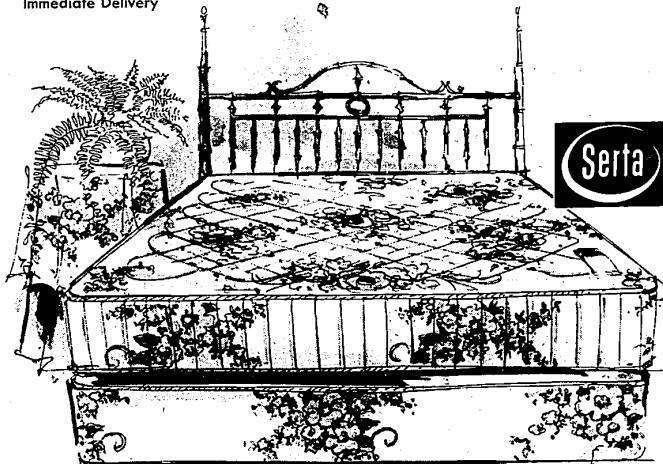
