**New Horizons Is Looking For A Home**


New Horizons is looking for a new home.

The agency, which operates a "sheltered workshop" for the mentally and physically handicapped at 35100 Grand River, Farmington, is expecting, to lose its present office when the land is sold, according to Mrs. Peg Prentice, director.

They are looking for a new building to lease with about 6,000 square feet of space.

"We feel like we have become part of the Farmington community," she said. They have been in the present location for seven years.

She said federal funds would be available for a new building if land were donated for the site. "But nobody seems to want to donate land, not out here," she said.

**School Accepts Tax Loan Bid**

**FARMINGTON** The Farmington Board of Education accepted the bid of National Bank of Detroit for \$3 million in tax anticipation notes.

NBD was low bidder with an interest rate of 2.65 per cent. The money, to be used to meet operating expenses during the current year, will be repaid in March 1973. Dr. Mervyn Ross, board treasurer, said interest will total \$31,670.

The borrowing was made necessary because the school year doesn't match the tax payment schedule.

The Michigan Municipal Finance Commission had approved the loan.

In other actions Tuesday night the board:

- Appointed Dr. Joseph W. Chaisson to be a junior high school principal and Miss Carolyn Plsek to be an elementary school principal for the 1972-73 school year. Neither was assigned a specific school.
- Chaisson was assistant principal at East Junior High School last year. Miss Plsek served as an administrative intern at Cloverdale, High Meadow and Flanders schools.
- Called a special board meeting for Tuesday, July 25, to take action on bids for construction of driveways and parking lots at Power Junior High in response to a teacher grievance.
- Agreed to reapply for a share of Oakland County's public employment program funds for a second year. The district last year received some \$45,000. Business Manager William Prisk reported, which permitted employment of six teachers and two clerk typists. Another \$5,000 appropriation allowed the Youth Employment Service to get under way. Prisk said.

The allocations call for 10 per cent in local matching funds but can be met in "in kind" contributions such as teaching space rather than in dollars, Prisk said.
