Jack Brokensha and his jazz group, with singer Ursula Walker, will stage a concert on Sunday, July 30, in the outdoor amphitheater of the Orchard Ridge Campus of Oakland Community College, 27055 Orchard Lake Road, Farmington.

Meadow Brook Stars Pianists

Mary Travers, pianist Alfred Brendel, Peter Nero and Skitch Henderson are the featured artists during the fifth week of the Meadow Brook Music Festival.

MARY TRAVERS will open the week with a concert on Wednesday evening, July 26, at 8:30 p.m. Calling herself a documentary singer rather than simply a folk singer, Mary selects songs from such contemporary writers as Bob Dylan, Nina Simone, Ewan McColl and John Denver.

Brilliant Austrian pianist Alfred Brendel will appear in two different concerts Thursday and Saturday evening at 8:30, with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra conducted by Slatan Ehrling. On the Thursday program he will play Beethoven's Piano Concerto No. 3 in C minor, Opus 57. On Saturday night the program will include Prokofiev and Mozart works.

Skitch Henderson, a popular television personality as well as a gifted musician, will conduct the symphony orchestra in a Sunday pops concert at 6:30 p.m. Selections will include Grofé's Mississippi Suite and a collection of Henderson's own arrangements, such as "Summer of '42," in which he will also play the piano solo part.

Curtain time for every performance this week is 8:30 p.m. except the Sunday Pops concert which will begin at 6:30. Tickets for all concerts are available at Hudson's Grinnell's, Wayne State University, Macomb County Community College, and the festival box office. Children under 12 are admitted for \$1 on the lawn for all concerts.

Arts Appointee

Willis F. Woods, director of the Detroit Institute of Arts, has been appointed to the Michigan Council for the Arts by Gov. William G. Milliken. Subject to Senate confirmation, Woods will serve a four-year term. He had been advisor of the council's visual arts committee.

Overture To Opera Joins National Unit

DETROIT — Detroit's Overture to Opera Company has been elected a member of Opera America, the national association and voice of professional opera companies.

As the 36th member of this organization, Overture to Opera is now associated with such prestigious companies as the Metropolitan Opera, the New York City Opera, the San Francisco Opera Association and the Chicago Lyric, among others.

AS A MEMBER Overture will enjoy many benefits. Opera America holds annual auditions and has grants-in-aid for young singers. This year alone, in cooperation with the National Opera Institute, there is \$5,000 apiece for 30 aspiring young singers.

Opera America also has regional cooperatives for physical scenery. In other words members loan their sets to other members rent-free.

Also, Opera America, again in cooperation with the National Opera Institute, has initiated an internship program for the operatic arts. This program provides instruction and experience for young professionals in non-

singing fields such as stage direction, management, lighting and costuming.

THE 1972 Overture to Opera fall season opens Sept. 28. All operas will be performed in English and will include such guest stars as Phyllis Curran, Muriel Greenspoon and Ronald Holgate.

Productions planned are Mozart's "Così fan tutte," and Puccini's "Tosca." Season tickets are now on sale at 383 Performing Arts Building, Oakland University, Rochester, 48063. Dr. David DiChiera is the general director.
