for the elective administrative offices," he said.

Among the reforms, he listed:

- Recruiting a professional public safety director (Ronald Holko).
- Improved the township building department.
- Established a "better relationship" with the county road commission.
- Worked to re-route a proposed 10 mile sewer arm away from the Quakertown "valley".
- Worked on a car disposal program.
- Began the use of ordinance violators to clean up around city hall.
- Improved the May cleanup "done in one-fifth the time for less money" than in the past.

But has he really "reformed" township hall?

Teeples criticizes most of these programs as inconsequential.

The most important appointment, that of Holko, was actually made by a committee of Trustees Fredrick Licht-

man, Earl Oppenheimer and Teeples. Holko, avoiding politics, points out the board approved his appointment unanimously.

THERE IS OPEN hostility on the part of Township Clerk Floyd Cairns and Treasurer Thomas Nolan, along with the township trustees. Literally and figuratively, Teeples is an "outsider" in township hall. "They're at odds with me," he says.

As a township supervisor, he has one vote on the seven-man board, the same as the clerk, treasurer and four trustees. The administrative officials are elected independently, and have to answer to nobody but the other board members.

The result is a near-total lack of communication between the administrative offices.

It appears the more partial old board members were to ex-supervisor Hall, the more hostile they are towards Teeples.
