LANSING Proposed legislation requiring thit persons who receive stolen goods must prove they brought the items were legitimate passed the Senate with approval from two Observerland senators. Sen. William Faust (D-Westland) and Sen. Carl Pursell (R-Plymouth) both voted for the bill, which passed 23-8 and was sent to Gov. Milliken for signature. The bill had passed the House several months ago. Sen. David Pahas Voted again the bill, and Sen. Daniel Cooper (D-Dak Park) was absent. The bill would make the receiver of stolen goods liable for the same penalty as the bill.
