

# Conservatives Select Wells

Southfield Attorney James Wells has been nominated by the Conservative Party of Michigan for a seat on the State Board of Education in the Nov. 7 election.

"'Mickey Mouse' parties rarely win," Wells said, "but we will try to affect the major portion of thinking on the important issue of independent neighborhood schools."

Wells is attorney for the recently-formed Southfield Academies, Neighborhood Academy of Postville, and Finance. All Children's Education (FACE).

The groups jointly sponsored a petition drive for a constitutional amendment on the November ballot in an effort to obtain state funds for private schools. The effort failed.

Goebel, 26, will work with the Mobile Home Division of the Institute. Upon graduating from Michigan State University with honors, he taught mathematics in East Junior High of Farmington.

## Assessment Class Set At Oakland

ROCHESTER A new review program that prepares assessing officers of governmental bodies to take the State Assessors Board certification examination is offered by Oakland University's Division of Continuing Education.

The six-course review program that covers all phases of property tax assessment, begins the week of Sept. 25. The two-section program includes appraisal theory and appraisal techniques and assessment administration practices. One course in each section will be offered each term. Enrollees may complete the review program by June 1973 by taking courses each term.

The first two courses, basic appraisal theory for assessing officers and assessment administration for assessing officers, begin Monday Sept. 25, and Wednesday, Sept. 27, respectively. Courses are instructed by Ted Dwyer, president of Ted Dwyer Appraisal Associates of Jackson.

In 1969, State Act 203 established basic minimum requirements for assessing officers.

In the new review program, all of the material necessary and applicable to the examinations for certification

levels I-III will be covered. The level certifications are awarded upon completion of the examinations offered by the State Assessors Board. No certification is awarded as a result of attendance or completion of the review program courses.

The review program also is of interest to members of county boards of equalization, assessing administrative personnel in utilities, corporations and lending institutions.

### OU Offers Real Estate Courses

ROCHESTER Real estate firms are requiring both new and experienced salespeople and brokers to obtain additional knowledge so that they may better serve the public.

A large selection of real estate courses are offered in the fall term by Oakland University's division of continuing education to fill this need.

Individuals intending to take the state salesmen and brokers licensing examinations may enroll in the three Michigan Real Estate Assn. approved Graduate Realtor Institute courses. These are offered evenings and monthly in an accelerated four-day format. A one-day real estate math refresher class also is offered monthly.

More advanced courses include law, appraisal, finance, investment and strategy, exchanging and trading, residential construction, property taxation and operating the real estate office. Courses begin the week of Sept. 25.
