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arc or almost due east to west. You can take advantage of this situation by placing the main windows facing directly south. Depending upon the location of the lot, this may mean placing the house at right angles to the street. Most communities will allow a house to be positioned any way the owner wants, so do consider possibilities other than positioning your house to face the street.

Large glass areas facing north or west will result in high heating bills, even with double - layer glass. Those north winds are pretty strong. Landscaping can be helpful here.

Having the sun in the winter, but

not in the summer is a neat trick, and a good roof overhang does the job. Since the sun travels higher in summer, the overhang will keep the windows shaded. The lower path of the sun in winter will allow the sun to shine in on you. Proper ventilation in your attic and a light-color roofing material will keep your house cooler in summer. Deciduous trees will give you shade in the summer, and when the leaves fall, they will allow the sun to penetrate in the winter.

Proper orientation of your house makes you less dependent on fuels. Brownouts can come and go, and you will hardly notice.
