Accent Culture

ROCHESTER Parapsychology and an introduction to English art are among a variety of new cultural evening courses to be given this fall in Meadow Brook Hall on the campus of Oakland University.

The four- or five-week courses, which meet one evening per week, are offered by the division of continuing education.

PARAPSYCHOLOGY. a seminar investigation into psychic phenomena and attempted explanations, begins Sept. 27. Richard W. Brooks, associate professor of philosophy at OU, will lead the course which will deal with telepathy, clairvoyance, precognition, dreams and mediumistic trances.

The seminar will also explore the related phenomena of telekinesis, fortune-telling, ghosts and the role of drugs.

Introduction to English art will deal with English painting and architecture from the early 16th century to the early 19th century. To supplement the lecture and slides, Charles E. Brownell, assistant professor of art at OU, will make extensive use of the hall and its collection. This course begins Sept. 28.

IN "GHOSTS" in Literature," John P. Cutts, chairman of the university's English department, will lead an exploration into man's fascination with the supernatural as shown in world-famous literature. This begins Sept. 25.

The dos and don'ts of buying precious and semi-precious stones and the fundamentals of gemology will be presented by Boris Gaynes, beginning Sept. 25.

The popular beginning wine appreciation course gets under way Sept. 28. Each session is devoted to practical wine knowledge followed by comparative tasting of six different wines and imported cheeses.

The graduate wine appreciation course begins Oct. 24.
