

Candidate Night Set For Oct. 19

A "Meet Your Candidates Night" for congressional and state representative candidates will be held Thursday, Oct. 19, at 7:45 p.m. in West Middle School, 44401 W. Ann Arbor Trail, Plymouth.

The public is invited to the meeting at which candidates from the 2nd and 15th Congressional districts will be questioned. State representative candidates from the 35th, 36th, 37th and 32nd districts have also been invited.

The meeting is co-sponsored by the American Assn. of University Women and League of Women Voters. Each candidate will speak five minutes on "What do you consider the most important priorities for your legislative district for the next several years? What legislation would you propose or support to implement them?"

After the candidates speak, there will be an informal coffee where visitors can talk with the candidates.

THE 2nd DISTRICT takes in Livonia City and Plymouth City and Township. U.S. Rep. Marvin Bach (R-Ann Arbor) is the incumbent and is challenged by State Rep. Marvin Stempien (D-Livonia).

The 15th district includes Garden City, Westland and Canton Township and is currently represented by U.S. Rep. William D. Ford (D-Taylor). Ford is challenged by Republican Ernest Fackler.

The 35th State House District includes northern Livonia and Northville. Republican R. Robert Geake is running against Democrat Marie Miller for the seat formerly held by Stempien.

John Markes, Westland Democrat, and Ralph Miller, Westland Republican, are running in the 36th District which includes northern Westland and southwestern Livonia.

Incumbent Rep. Thomas Brown (D-Westland) is running against Republican Jack Underwood in the 37th District which includes Westland and Canton Township.

The 32nd district includes Plymouth City and Township where Democrat Bob Dwyer and Rep. Raymond Smith (R-Ann Arbor) are running against each other.

WCCC Students, Hours Up

Wayne County Community College Board reports an enrollment of 93,700 credits as of the end of the fall registration period, Sept. 22, representing over 13,000 students. It is a 10 per cent gain over the fall, 1971 term.

The figure allows for minor changes brought about by students dropping and adding courses, which is still under way.

In September 1971, 11,800 students were enrolled at WCCC.

"We are greatly pleased and encouraged by the continuing increase of interest by students in programs offered by this college," said WCCC President Reginald Wilson. "Significantly, student growth occurred throughout the county at each of our 26 instructional centers. The enrollment increase provides a more substantial base from which to build our academic, career and service programs."

The 10 per cent gain in WCCC enrollment was reported while most of the state's institutions of higher education were experiencing drops in student enrollment or were just holding even compared with last year's figures. Schoolcraft and Oakland Community Colleges showed drops this year.

A 16 per cent increase in the number of credit hours enrolled was also reported, indicating that students are taking heavier class loads than last year.

WCCC is now in its fourth year of operation. The college now offers courses in 62 subject areas, including courses leading to certificates in vocational programs as well as associate degrees which provide entry into four-year institutions at the junior year level.


