



Game Time Over For OCC Paper

With a new crew and fresh wind, Orchard Ridge's campus newspaper should sail on a new course this year as its first woman editor takes her place at the helm.

Chris Geyer, 21-year-old sophomore from Royal Oak, defeated two male students last spring for the editorship of Recorder, student publication of Oakland Community College's Farmington campus. That makes her the first woman student to get the post.

The election by the newspaper staff was just the first rough course she had to weather, but now she smiles confidently while discussing her plans for the paper.

The course will differ from last year's when the threat of suspension hung over the publication and culminated in a temporary suspension in the spring.

"IT WAS LIKE a super daydream," Miss Geyer said of last year's editorial direction. The staff was mostly interested in "peace, love and dope," she said. "That was fine for awhile, but it's over now."

The newspaper was very political last year, but Miss Geyer says that this year the paper will cover all student groups and activities.

"There was a growing segment of the student population, who were being turned off because they couldn't relate to the newspaper last year," Miss Geyer said. "We want to change that and make it more relevant to student interests."

"There are quite a few opinions around here that haven't been expressed. We're going to try to bring them out."
