After the first killing frost, pile soil at least six inches high around the base. (Dig soil from another part of the garden so you do not injure the roots of the rose plants.)

Draw the canes together and place a waterproof paper cylinder or a special rose cylinder over each bush. Cut the plant tops off even with the pof the cylinder.
