'Public Airports Needed'

State Aeronautics Director James D. Ramsey says that the development of publicly-owned airports in the Detroit area "is being badly neglected."

"Local governing bodies, particularly in the Detroit metropolitan area, have not faced their responsibility to provide publicly-owned airport facilities for general aviation," he said.

"Outstate areas should look at the greater Detroit problem and act now to forestall a similar problem in the not too distant future."

Ramsey said several privately-owned airports that are licensed for public use face the prospect of closing because the value of the land they are on has increased to the point where the owners plan to sell them for other uses.

"The closing of privately-owned airports increases the congestion at the large airports such as Detroit Metropolitan and Detroit City," he said.






