Regional Volunteerism Is Explored

Voluntary cooperation as a method of solving southeastern Michigan problems will be discussed tonight (Wednesday) at 8 p.m. in the seventh of 12 seminars on regional governance.

"Inter-governmental Volunteerism: Pro and Con" will be discussed in the memorial room of the McKenzie Library Science Building of St. Clair County Community College, 323 Erie, Port Huron.

Presenting the paper will be Dr. Henry Schmandt, professor of urban affairs and political science at the University of Wisconsin, Milwaukee.

Dr. Schmandt considers inter-governmental volunteerism one of the most influential concepts in urban political history, though not a total solution to urban problems.

The seminar is one of the monthly series of "Regionalist Papers" sponsored by the local colleges and Metropolitan Fund, Inc., a non-profit education and research foundation serving the six counties of southeast Michigan. All are open to the public without charge.

Masin Jr. (D-Oak Park); Elta Reid of the Port Huron League of Women Voters; Gerald Remus of the Detroit Metropolitan Water Department; and Mayor David Sheper of Oak Park.

Bradner Gets EMU Post

Eric J. Bradner, president emeritus of Schoolcraft College, has been appointed to the newly created position of community college consultant at Eastern Michigan University.

His major concern will be relations with such colleges and to make them aware of EMU facilities that may be of assistance.

In 1961, Bradner assisted in the formation of the community college district which operates Schoolcraft. He was named president of the college in January 1962 and was a major factor in its subsequent growth. He retired from that post on July 1, 1971, and was granted emeritus status.
