• A card offered by the Foundation for Mentally Ill Children, Inc., showing a red reindeer and tree design that was drawn by a nine-year-old boy in the Fairview Center of Pontiac State Hospital. The cards, \$5 for 25, are available from the Foundation for the Mentally Ill Children, Box 245, Bloomfield Hills 48013.

• A bright snow scene card offered by the Lapeer Parents Association to help all

retarded and especially residents of the Lapeer State Home and Training School. Packaged 20 in a box for \$2.50, they may be ordered from the association office, 30629 Pierce, Southfield.

• The Kidney Foundation's choice of four designs, a snow scene, a Christmas package, a Santa and a Christmas note with a holly border. They range in price from \$3.25 to \$7 cards. This year, all proceeds will go towards the hospital's tumor clinic (the only solid tumor clinic for children in the state). The card was designed by Fran Thorson, a Michigan artist. The cards are \$3.75 for a box of 25 and imprinting is available at \$2 for the first 50 cards, 50 cents for each additional 25 cards.
