

SC Extension Branch Opens

Schoolcraft College will offer 26 evening credit classes in Garden City during the winter semester and will open a permanent office to serve the southern area of the college district.

As part of its drive to increase student enrollments, the college will offer classes in Garden City West High School, 1851 Radcliffe.

The office will be located in Florence School, 29203 Florence Street east of Middle Belt. The opening date is uncertain.

"WE'RE DELIGHTED to be able to offer evening classes in Garden City at the West High School," college President C. Nelson Grote said. "Hopefully many people who live in the southern area of the college district will find it more convenient to take college classes there."

"It will give us an opportunity to evaluate the success of taking a complement of courses into our district on an extension basis," he added.

The extension office will be financed from a state grant to the college.

A \$100,000 grant was given to Schoolcraft after its state appropriations were slashed from original projections. The grant must be spent according to certain guidelines provided by the state.

The exact allocation to the Garden City office has not been determined, but it is this money which will be used to pay the rent and hire a full-time person to staff the office.

COLLEGE DISTRICT residents will get a publication of the college courses in the mail.

A special registration period for evening classes will be held from 6 to 9 p.m. on Dec. 4-7 in Florence School.

On-campus advance registration will be held from 8:30 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. daily Nov. 13 to 17 and on the Fridays of Dec. 1, 8 and 15 at the same times.

Regular registration for evening students will be Jan. 3, 4 from 6:30 to 8:30 p.m.
