

# Center Will Break Ground

Ground will be broken Sunday, Nov. 19, for the first building in a complex projected by the Farmington Hills Christian Center.

The total development, to be located at Freedom and Drake roads at I-96, is described by the Rev. E. Eugene Perrault as "a synergistic service to the Farmington community—not only a church but a total center, senior citizens' village and education plant as well as the chapel and activities building which soon will be under construction.

In addition to the ground-breaking, the church plans a weekend missionary convention to show its wide range of ministry. 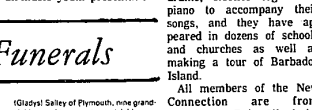
