"My comment was directed only toward one minister's son, George McGovern, who has in his campaign wrapped himself in his father's mantle.

"Perhaps my statement in this regard was unfortunate, and perhaps too colorful. The only untruthful ministers' sons I have known are this school classmate and my boss' opponent."

RARELY HAVE any of the Nixon administration insiders so apologized -- most of them reportedly being as religiously self-assured as presidential press secretary Ron Ziegler.

And Ehrlichman's apology may help alleviate the burden upon all ministers' sons -- such as being reared in the goldfish bowl of a personage, where in the event of any misbehavior at all, the gossip can gallop.
