

A test car brakes to a stop on glare ice during the National Safety Council's winter driving test program. Stopping ability of various types of fires, tire chains and other equipment are evaluated in the annual test program.



The above char, prepared by the Sale Winter Driving League, illustrates the extéme hazard of driving on glare ice. Tests show that with regular tires stopping distances on plare ice may be nearly nine times the normal, dry pavement distance. Studded tires reduce braking distance by 19 gerent while reinforced tire chains cut braking distance by 50 percent. Regardless of the help provided by this equipment, however, the League warns motorists that far slower than normal speeds are essential when driving on icy pavements.
