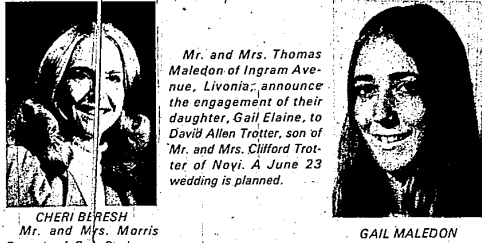
Stephanie Lignell of Benton Harbor was flower girl.
