



Shot At The Buzzer Wins It For Borgess, 79-78

Bishop Borgess senior Rick Schornack enjoyed one of the finest hours a prep cager could ask.

No, he didn't score 50 points or haul in 50 rebounds or take on the opponent single-handed.

All Schornack did was to score two baskets, that's all just four points.

But they were four points that Schornack and Jim Brisky's Borgess cagers will long remember.

The two field goals came in an overtime period against St. Mary of Redford, the last one leaving his finger tips at the buzzer. It was a 12-foot jumper, hitting the rim and gripping through the hoop after time had already expired, giving Borgess a 79-78 victory.

And the way the Borgess squad swarmed over Schornack, one might have thought that the Spartans had just wrapped up the state championship.

For Brisky it was win No. 2 in Catholic Double A action, giving Borgess a 2-2 league mark and 4-5 overall.

The Borgess squad, which is in its first year of Double A competition, is beginning to make waves.

"Nobody expected us to do anything in the Double A," said Brisky. "And here we are, two and two, right in the middle of it all."

THE TRIUMPH was the second straight for Borgess, with the starting five all hitting in double figures.

Don Kelly was high with 19 points followed by Greg Dryden with 17, Shawn McCarthy at 14, Mark Sopko with 13 and Paul Davis with 12.

Schornack was the only other Spartan to break into the scoring column with just those four points.

St. Mary Redford took a 15-12 first quarter lead but Borgess woke up to carry a 35-

27 margin into the locker room at the half.

REDFORD CARRIED the play in the third stanza, outscoring Borgess, 23-13, to take a 50-48 advantage going into the fourth.

Schornack drove in and from 12 feet out did his thing and Borgess was a winner.

Borgess hit on 31 of 56 for 54 per cent from the field and St. Mary connected on 28 of 64 for 44 per cent.

Rebounding was a dominant factor for Borgess with 6-3 Sopko and 6-1 Davis hauling in 18 and 11 respectively, with the Spartans winning the board game, 59-37.

Borgess travels to Shrine Friday for another Double A clash: Both teams sport 2-2 league marks behind 4-4 Service and tied with Divine Child, also at 2-2.

Bentley Jars Tigers, Falls To Flint Central

Balance is fast becoming the key word in the current Bentley High basketball campaign.

When the Bulldogs reveal a balanced attack, John Farrar usually chalks up another victory. When there is no sign of balance, there is usually no inkling of a win.

The Bulldogs have shown overall balance thus far in the Suburban Eight and are tied for first with powerful Allen Park at 3-0, triumph No. 3 coming over Belleville in a come-from-behind clash, 72-67.

Outside the league, the Bulldogs haven't fared as well.

FLINT CENTRAL crushed the Bulldogs the night after the Belleville win, 89-63, to

give Bentley a 2-3 non-league mark, 5-3 overall.

"I wasn't really discouraged with the loss to Flint Central," said Farrar. "I was glad to get by Belleville and the kids are pointing toward the league."

"The next three games should pretty much tell the story of our season."

Bentley travels to Plymouth Friday night, then hosts Redford Union and journeys to Allen Park the following week, with a

Belleville jumped out ahead of Bentley after one quarter, 21-15, but the Bulldogs caught themselves for a moment and edged up, 27-15, with 3:30 remaining in the first half.
