LWV To Consider Federal Role In Solid Wastes

The problem of solid wastes and the federal role in recycling will come up for consensus in the meeting of the Plymouth Northville League of Women Voters at 8 p.m. Thursday, Jan. 11. The meeting will be held in Epiphany Lutheran Church on Five Mile in Plymouth Township.

Mrs. Donald Stacy, president, said the issue on which consensus will be taken is "Environmental Quality: The Federal Role in Recycling and Solid Waste Management."

The decision reached by the local league is forwarded to the state and national league boards who analyze consensus reports from all over the country.

THIS MAJORITY opinion then is formulated into a national LWV position statement, and the league can then begin to take direct action through legislative process.

Y Offers Course In History

The YWCA is offering a discussion-study course dealing with the contributions of black people to American life, beginning at 7:30 p.m., Tuesday, Jan. 23, in the Y, 1034 Monroe, Dearborn. Pre-registration is required.

The course is entitled "Unwritten History." It will be taught by Ernest Hughes, who recently served as a captain in the USAF. While in the service, he developed and taught courses in black history to armed forces personnel in southeast Asia. He is a graduate of Western Michigan University with a degree in sociology.

The course will present little-known information on the work of black people in the arts, sciences, religion and politics. As examples, the first open heart surgery was done by a black surgeon in Chicago; Black Bart was a black man; "Jim Crow" laws did not exist before 1810; blacks served in the U.S. Congress after the Civil War; and the first settler of Chicago was a black man.
