### Tax Estimate Deadline Is Jan. 15

Deadline for final payment of 1972 estimated federal individu-ai income tax is Monday, Jan. 15, sald Thomas A. Cardoza, district director of Internal Revenue for Michigan.

Some taxpayers may have to make an amended estimate by Jan. 15] if their income changed substantially during the last quarter of 1972. The worksheet contained in the 1972 estimated tax package received by taxpayers provides space to compute an amended estimate.

Other taxpayers may have to file an original 1972 declaration on Form 1040-ES by Jan. 15, if they just met the filing require-ments during the fourth quart-er, according to Mr. Cardoza.

Taxpayers do not have to pay the last installment or file an original or amended declara-tion otherwise due Jan. 15 if they file their 1972 income tax returns and pay all of the tax due by Wednesday, Jan. 31.

Due dates are different for farmers and commercial fisher-men, Mr. Cardoza said. Publica-tion 505, "Tax Withholding and Declaration of Estimated Tax," Declaration of Estimated 1ax, furnishes additional informa-tion on this subject. It is availa-ble free, in person or by mail, from your IRS district office.




