

Fackler Named Chairman

GOP Eyes Local Races In The 15th

Fifteenth Congressional District Republicans will concentrate on winning local city, township, and school board races in 1973.

That and improving communications with the party's State Central Committee are the primary goals of the district's new chairman, Ernest Fackler of Dearborn Heights.

Fackler, 29, was elected without opposition at the party's district convention in the Hilton Inn in Romulus.

FACKLER, Michigan workmen compensation bureau director since last fall, outlined his plans for the district during a coffee break at the convention.

The party will work on local political races, electing 15th District people to city and school board positions in the hope of having qualified candidates to run for state positions in 1974.

"We forget parties are supposed to win elections," the chairman said.

who will have Republican support.

Two Westland precinct delegates, Ralph Miller and Gary Dixon, admitted that they are considering council races this year.

Miller was the party's nominee in the 36th State House campaign last fall and lost to Democrat John Markes by 235 votes out of 26,000 votes cast.

Dixon is Westland Republican chairman and a candidate for the State Central Committee, which will be elected at the state convention in Detroit on Feb. 16-17.

THE COMMUNICATIONS problem with higher GOP officials may be improved soon, Fackler said in announcing that the Feb. 14 district board meeting will have State Chairman Bill McLaughlin as guest speaker.

It will be the first time in four or five years McLaughlin has been at a board meeting in the district, Fackler said.

There will be competition for State Central Committee openings with three men and three women announcing their candidacies. Two of each are to be elected.

The only Observerland candidates are Dixon and Wayne's Brian Arrowsmith, newly-elected county commissioner whose district includes the southern portion of Westland and Canton Township.

Dixon told the convention, attended by one-third of the 150 eligible delegates, that he increased attendance at Westland Republican Club meetings, managed Miller's state house campaign, and worked on the Westland Spring festival.

He cited his leadership and organizational abilities in running for state central.

IN OTHER business at the convention, the delegates elected district officers and picked state convention delegates.

District officers for the next two years are Dorothy Evans, first vice chairman; Jon Campbell, secretary, and Vern Copeland, treasurer.

Westland delegates to the state convention will be Audrey Gibson, Betty Mc-

Cutcheon, Delores Newell, Delene Dixon, Norman Stockmeyer, Harvey Schartzbauer, Ralph Miller, Lou Waggoner, Matt Harbison and Dixon.

Garden City delegates are Al Haney, Harold Fowers, Don Castoldini, Jon Campbell, and Allen Miller.

Representing Canton Township are James Poole, township trustee, and James Walasky.

The delegate approved resolutions honoring Dwight Vincent, district chairman since it was created in 1961, other retiring officers, President Nixon's efforts to end the Vietnam War and bring a "generation of peace," and Gov. Milliken's proposed tax cuts.

REP. MARVIN ESCH (R-Ann Arbor) will be the guest speaker for the annual Lincoln Day banquet sponsored by the 15th Congressional District Republic Party on Friday night, Feb. 23, in Dearborn Inn. Esch was re-elected to a fourth term in Congress Nov. 7.

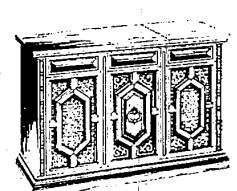

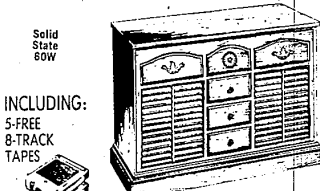

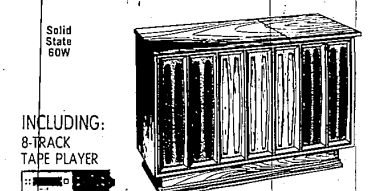
