Letter To The Editor Lawyer Replies

EDITOR:
Your editorial comment on Jan. 31 that the charter commission got "bad legal advice" has gored my ox, and I feel that I must reply.

The operative statute which controls public meetings today is Act 261, of the Public Acts of 1968, not the Home Rule Cities Act. The Michigan Supreme Court as recently as December 1972 ruled that general laws of the state will supersede charter provisions.

Act 261 of 1968 applies to city councils. The language in the proposed Farmington Hills charter, which you find to be "unwieldy," is copied

Center Starts 2 New Classes

FARMINGTON
Two new classes and two established favorites will begin this month at Farmington Community Center.

A six-class course in "Gardening and Landscape Design," taught by Observer Newspapers columnist Betty Frankel, will get the spring season under way.

"New Approaches to Interior Decorating," taught by Carole Caplan, will offer ideas for giving the home a spring "tuneup."

Old favorites returning are candlecraft and needlepoint workshops.

FOR THE FIRST time, the center also will offer a babysitting service on Tuesdays from 12:30 to 3 p.m. and on Thursdays from 9:30 to 11 a.m. Cost will be one dollar per child and \$1.75 for two children in the same family.

Mrs. Frankel's class will be on Tuesdays from 1 to 3 p.m. and will cost \$16 for the six sessions.

Mrs. Frankel holds a BS in botany from the University of Michigan and is completing her master's in landscape architecture.

She is an affiliate of the American Society of Landscape Architects and a member of the Professional Garden Writers of America. Her class is limited in number so that students may bring their own projects for review and advice.

MRS. CAPLAN has been a practicing decorator for 12 years, lectures at Oakland Community College and has taught at the Birmingham Community House.

She provides not only the basics of good interior design but ideas for adapting them to individual taste and environment. Her class will begin Feb. 15 and will meet from 9:30 to 11 a.m. for six sessions at a cost of \$20.

Candlecraft, taught by Mrs. Katherine Lemon, will emphasize springtime occasions with wax creations for Easter, birthdays, weddings and anniversaries. The four sessions, beginning Feb. 17, will be offered for \$14 plus materials.

Carol Kenyon and Lynn Malpell's Needlepoint I workshop will start Tuesday.
