

County Plans More Gravel

PONTIAC
Oakland County's share of the additional two cent gas tax revenues will be allocated to increase the gravel patching program.

About 20,000 tons of gravel and slag at a cost of \$100,000 were used in 1972. The county plans to use 80,000 tons at \$100,000 during 1973, states William M. Richards, chairman of the Oakland County Road Commission.

"Our immediate goal is to repair or improve the many fairly short sections that are substantially worse than the remainder of the same roadway," says Richards.

"We still won't have sufficient funds, however, to regrade all roads on a continuous basis."

Other members of the road commission are Frazer W. Staman, vice chairman, and commissioner Fred L. Harris. Commission engineer-manager is Paul Van Roekel.



Percy Is Speaker For Oakland GOP Lincoln Day Banquet

U.S. Sen. Charles H. Percy (R-Ill.) will be guest speaker Monday, Feb. 19, for the 84th annual Oakland County Lincoln Day banquet in Raleigh House, Southfield.

The county Republican club has held an annual program in honor of Lincoln each year since 1890, the longest consecutive record of any GOP organization in the U.S.

In 1949, Percy was named one of the 10 outstanding young men in America by the U.S. Jaycees.

In 1964, Percy ran for Illinois and was defeated by incumbent Democrat Otto Kerner.

PERCY is an often-mentioned contender for the 1976 Republican nomination for president.

Robert E. Beach, club president, expects this year's banquet to be the largest ever held in Oakland County.

The banquet traditionally has been a low-cost event, he adds, designed to appeal to Republican volunteers and supporters.

Percy, at age 29, was named president and chief executive officer of Bell & Howell in Chicago.

While he was president or chairman of the board, Bell & Howell sales increased from \$13 million to \$160 million and number of employees from 1,600 to more than 10,000.
