Parking Is Reviewed

FARMINGTON Restricting parking of Farmington Road between Grand River and Shiawassee was tabled Monday by the City Council.

The move is the latest in several changes downtown aimed at improving traffic conditions in the area. Proposed is eliminating parking on both sides of Farmington between Oakland and Shiawassee, and making a

"no parking" zone from 3 to 6 p.m. between Grand River and Oakland.

A petition from 10 residents on Farmington Road protesting the parking restriction was received by the council.

Villages Tax Forms Different

FARMINGTON The clerk's offices of Quakertown and Wood Creek Farms Villages are warning residents to correctly fill out the federal income tax form in order for the villages to get their fair cut of federal shared revenue.

The government is using statistics from income tax forms to update census figures, which are used to compute the villages share of federal shared revenue.

In order for the government to get an accurate count, villagers should indicate on line 33 section C, the village in which they reside.

Contrary to a report in last week's edition, village residents are not included in the Farmington Township sharing program.

In order for township residents to be counted, they must check the box in 33 C and write in Farmington in section D.
