Pre-School Sessions Start In C'ville

Pre-schoolers in Clarenceville are being introduced to basic concepts preparatory to entering school via preschool programs in the district's elementary schools.

Grandview school began its program Tuesday, Feb. 20, for children who will enter kindergarten in September. Sessions will be held in the school from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. each Tuesday for 10 weeks.

Botsford's program began Feb. 6. Hours are from 9:30 to 10:30 a.m. each Tuesday and Friday. Edgewood's program will begin March 6 with hours set at 9:35 a.m. to 10:45 a.m. The program will be in operation 10 weeks.

No definite plans have been made for the program at Westbrook school.

In all programs the children are given the opportunity to visit school buildings and enjoy the experiences as members of a group. During the time children are in preschool sessions parents will hear speakers discuss school and community programs.

C'ville Sets Kids' Clinics

The special services department of Clarenceville School District is offering through June a monthly pre-school clinic with sessions held the first Monday of each month from 1 to 4 p.m. at Botsford Elementary School.

Parents are invited to bring children who range up to five years.

School personnel who attend sessions to assist parents and children include the school nurse, who answers questions relating to health problems; the social worker, who aids with any problems relating to management or behavior; the speech therapist, who aids with any speech or language problems; and the school psychologist, who helps parents concerned over the emotional behavior of their children.

Each child with his parent is seen separately. Anyone with questions regarding the clinic or who wishes to make an appointment may call the special services department which is located in the board of education office.
