"Lanes and paths would provide safety and convenience to bicyclists throughout the nation," he said.

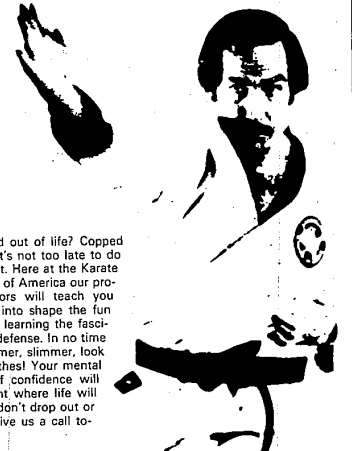
Howmet Net Shows Boost

Howmet Corp. of Greenwich, Conn., which has one of its plants in Plymouth, reports 1972 net income after extraordinary items equal to \$2.49 per share compared to \$1.38 per share in 1971.

Income from continuing operations amounted to \$13.2 million, with extraordinary income reaching nearly \$11.1 million. Combined, net income was reported as \$24.3 million compared to 1971's \$13.2 million.

In Howmet's year-end report, sales of both years were restated to eliminate the sales of operations whose disposition is expected.

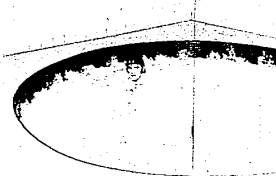

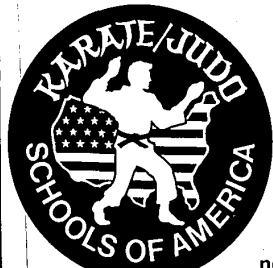
