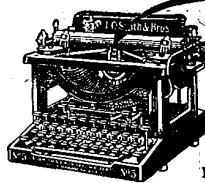
Ringling Circus is Announced

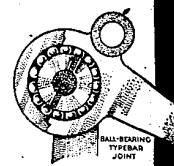
