Outdoor Lighting Useful

Carefully planned, creative lighting of these areas puts them at their best advantage, according to D. Newton Glick, professor and associate direc-tor of urban planning and land-scape architecture af Michigan State University.

Outdoor lighting need not be expensive or elaborate to be effective; single covered bubs placed in the proper places can make an unusual and attractive setting, he said.

Areas and scenes that aren't usually visible after dark can become useful and attractive with the proper lighting, Glick said. A flick of a switch can produce 2 charming garden scene out of a sea of darkness,

Besity is only one use for out-door lighting, Gilck said work, play, family entertaining, safely and protection are all legitimate uses for exterior lighting, He pointed out that many activities of work and play are more com-fortably done after sunset during spring, summer and fall when the air is cooler.

FOR PLAY, Glick recommended a light source well above sye level of the players to keep direct light out of their eyes. Lights can be placed on a building or pole for this purpose.

He said intruders are less likely to enter lighted areas than dark ones and suggested placing light switches in bed-rooms and other convenient places so that outdoor lights may be turned on quickly.

Whether outdoor lighting will be useful or solely decorative it can always be attractive. Glick gave some pointers for planning lighted areas outside:

-Accent the most interesting features of your garden; hide the less attractive areas by leaving

-Side or back lighting can be dramatic; front lighting is more likely to produce flat, uninter-esting effects.

_PLAN FOR year-round effects, Every season provides interesting material for outdoor lighting.

Create interesting patterns with light, Watch reflections; shadows, shades of foliage for their best uses.

-Vary the light strength and use indirect lighting whenever possible. An evenly lighted area seldom creates an interesting picture.

-Control the amount of light. Do not try to produce a day-time appearance. Too little

Glick noted that consideration must be given to neighbors when outdoor lighting is to be installed, He suggested placing shelded on light are, better yet, placing them where they will not disturb others.

"Underground circuits are the most permanent and salisfactory for outdoor lighting, but must be protected from insect and rodent damage, be capable of withstanding freezing and thawing wealther and must be protected against damage from moisture and digging," be said.

Circuits above ground are less attractive and less per-manent than the underground type but are easier to install and maintain, These circuits

may consist of overhead wires supported by posts, trees or buildings, or of wires 'hidden on the backs of walls and fences. For temporary use, specially treeked extension cords may be used but are not recommended because of the danger to people and equipment when wiring is exposed, Glick said.

HIS SUGGESTIONS for would-be outdoor lamp-lighters in-cluded:

—Ground all outdoor lighting with three-wire cords, a three-proaged ping and a grounded install sprace circuits for outdoor use rather than over-loading existing indoor circuits. —Hire an electrician for per-manent installations or when several lights are to be in-stalled,

-Be sure switches, sockets, oullet boxes, splice boxes and all other equipment is weather-proof and installed correctly before they are used.
