James Tierney, (D-Garden City), who is seeking reelection to the state Legislature from the 38th District, admitted a deep sense of shock at what he termed a "personal attack" by his primary opponent, Donald Sellers.

"I have no desire to engage in a mud-slinging contest," he said, "but I know the people of my district will not be misled by this cheap political device. Character assassination is as old as time and usually is used by a candidate who has nothing to offer as a smokescreen to hide his lack of qualification for the office."

Rep. Tierney took the charges one at a time and answered them.

"MY OPPONENT claims I am a racist," he said, "because I spoke out against violence, but I have said that violence is wrong and that it is a subversion of the democratic process."

"Years ago I worked hard to help Michigan's Fair Employment Practices Act to become a reality. It is true that I never have allocated my efforts on the basis of race, creed or color. Instead, I have acted solely on the basis of the needs of the people."

Tierney also explained his stand against the housing law, "I feel strongly that a property owner has a right to use his own judgment in disposing of his own property—which sometimes represents a life time of savings."

Concerned Democrats Pick Dupont

The endorsement of Dupont said:
