## BANDITS HEADED TOWARD BORDER

GENERAL TREVINO SAYS SMALL  
GROUPS OF OUTLAWS ARE  
ON WAY TO OJINAGA.

**SENDS NOTICE TO AMERICANS**

The Number of Bandits is Estimated  
at Two Hundred—Guards Are On  
the Lookout to Intercept Them.

Chihuahua City, Mexico—Several  
scattered groups of Villa followers  
have eluded the cordon of government  
troops which surrounded them in the  
Rio Florida bottoms and have reas-  
sembled at Tunajia and Las Escobas,  
on the road to Ojinaga, and are mak-  
ing their way north with the object of  
making another raid on the American  
border, according to confidential ad-  
vices to General Javito Trevino.

The advice which came from Santa  
Rosalia, said the outlaws skirted Chih-  
huahua City by traveling in small  
groups to the little settlements north-  
east of here.

General Trevino immediately or-  
dered the commanders of the garrisons at  
Ojinaga and Piedras Negras to throw  
troops out in an attempt to intercept  
the bandits, whose numbers were es-  
timated at about 200.

He pointed out, however, that the  
nature of the terrain is such that some  
of the outlaws might evade the govern-  
ment troops and suggested that it  
would be well for military authorities  
on the American side of the frontier  
to be especially vigilant.

"With the advent of the rainy sea-  
son," he said, "the abundant water  
supply makes it easy for small bands  
to deviate from beaten roads and old  
water holes. However, the Mexican  
troops will do everything they can to  
prevent the bandits reaching the Amer-  
ican border."

**TUG RESCUES MARINES  
ON BOARD THE HECTOR**

Big Collier Was Left to its Fate Af-  
ter Crew Leaves on Steamer  
Cypress.

Charleston, S. C.—Tales of the un-  
successful fight of the naval collier  
Hector against a gale which blew from  
110 to 120 miles an hour, great seas,  
fired and disabled engines and the  
daring rescue of 102 men by the tug  
Wellington were brought here by the  
first survivors to land. The Wellin-  
ton, storm battered and having lost  
two hours, worked for six hours  
taking off the crew and 60 marines  
which the Hector was taking from  
Port Royal to Guantanamo.

Captain Joseph Newell, of the He-  
ctor, and about 20 men were taken off  
later by the steamer Cypress, and the  
broken Hector was left to her fate,  
seven miles northeast of Cape Ro-  
maline gas buoy. No member of the  
ship's company was lost, but four  
were hurt.

As the big collier rolled at the whim  
of the wind which was driving her  
toward Cape Romalne, fires broke out  
in the hold. They did not gain head-  
way, but added to the terror of those  
aboard. The Wellington reached the  
collier about one hour after the He-  
ctor had grounded 14 miles north-nor-  
theast of Cape Romalne.

The Hector's launch had been dis-  
abled by the storm, but a small boat  
with a line was put out and succeeded  
in reaching the Wellington. The dan-  
gerous work of transferring the men  
was immediately started and contin-  
ued for six hours.

**BRITISH BREAK SECOND LINE**

Devil's Wood Taken By South  
African Troops.

British Front in France, via London.  
—Continuing their offensive, the Brit-  
ish, who July 15, broke through the  
German second line of defense, now  
have taken all of Devil's Wood, which  
was stormed by the South Africans,  
and the Highwood, establishing them-  
selves beyond Bazentin le Petit, ad-  
vanced parties having been to the  
outskirts of Martinpuich and Pozieres  
and other points close to the third  
German line of defense. The weather  
remains dry and warm.

The Anglo-French advance has  
brought the Allied troops, where they  
make a junction to a point about a  
mile in front of Combes, which prior  
to July 1, when the offensive began,  
was the German headquarters on this  
sector.

The casualty lists as announced,  
total 227 officers dead and 427  
wounded or missing; 597 men dead,  
and 1,832 wounded.

Raleigh, N. C.—Thirteen persons  
dead, at least 10 missing and property  
damage estimated at around \$15,000,  
is the known toll of flood in five  
southern states.

Memphis, Tenn.—The new Hachran  
bridge spanning the Mississippi river  
at Memphis, said to be the largest  
structure on the river, was opened to  
traffic for the first time. It cost \$5,  
000,000. Including the approach, the  
bridge is three miles long, the bridge  
proper being 2,600 feet. Construction  
was started in 1913.
